

CARES Act Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds

The CARES Act Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) provides funding to institutions for emergency financial aid grants to students whose lives have been disrupted by the coronavirus pandemic. Below is **Myrangel Beauty Institute's 45 days report**.

With regard to the CARES Act Section 18004(a) (1), Myrangel Beauty Institute acknowledges and assures that:

1. A signed Certification and Agreement was returned to the Department of Education on April 12, 2020 with the intention of using 50% of the funds received to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. The total amount of funds that **Myrangel Beauty Institute** received for the benefit of students is \$273,013.
3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the Cares Act as the date of submission of March 22, 2021 is \$263,445.00
4. The estimated number of students eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act is 145.
5. As of March 22, 2021 138 students have received funding.
6. **Myrangel Beauty Institute** determined that all eligible students who fill out application and acceptance forms according to Emergency Grants for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus (including eligible expenses under a student's cost of attendance such as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and child care) will receive the Emergency Financial Aid Grants under Section 18004(a)(1) of the Cares Act into two installments and taking in consideration the requirements for eligibility.
7. The students were notified by email who will be eligible for emergency aid and the requirements. Also, the institution will notify the students by email and thru their instructors when the second disbursement will be.
