

Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) and ARP

CRRSAA (HEERF II) provides funding to institutions for emergency financial aid grants to students whose lives have been disrupted by the coronavirus pandemic. Below is Myrangel Beauty Institute's fifth report.

With regard to the CRRSAA Act Section (CFDA 84.425E) or Proprietary Institution Grant Funds for Students (CFDA 84.425Q), Myrangel Beauty Institute acknowledges and assures that:

1. A signed Certification and Agreement was returned to the Department of Education on March 17, 2021 with the intention of using the funds received to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. The total amount of funds that Myrangel Beauty Institute received for the benefit of students is \$264,432.00 plus 157,210.00 supplemental (ARP) equal \$421,642.00
3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the Cares Act as the date of submission of March 31, 2022 is \$374,916.00
4. As of March 31, 2022 293 students have received funding.
5. Myrangel Beauty Institute determined that all eligible students who fill out application and acceptance forms according to Emergency Grants for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus (including eligible expenses under a student's cost of attendance such as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and child care) will receive an equal amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants under Section 9CFDA 84.425E) of the CRRSAA Act and ARP into one or two installments and taking in consideration the requirements for eligibility.
6. The students were notified through Financial Aid Office with instructions of who will be eligible for emergency aid and the requirements. Also, to the date that the distribution of the grants will begin.
